

RECOGNIZE ILL TRAVELER

- Look for or ask about Ebola symptoms.

ISOLATE

- Separate the ill traveler from others to the extent possible.
- **If at gate** and having close contact (within one meter) with the ill traveler, use appropriate personal protective equipment such as face mask, gloves, and face shield or goggles.
- **If during flight** and having close contact (within one meter) with the ill traveler, use universal precaution kit.

NOTIFY

- **If at gate**, follow your airline or airport's procedures to request a medical evaluation or assistance. A traveler may be denied boarding.
- **If during flight**, pilot reports to Air Traffic Control per ICAO requirement.

GIVE SUPPORT

- Follow instructions from your airline or public health authority.

EBOLA SYMPTOMS*

Alert your supervisor about any traveler who has:

- FEVER** of 100.4°F/38°C or higher (including history of feeling feverish)

OR

- ONE or more** of the following conditions:

- Severe headache
- Muscle pain
- Vomiting
- Diarrhea
- Stomach pain
- Unexplained bruising or bleeding
