

RECOGNIZE ILL TRAVELER

Look, listen, or ask for signs and symptoms of illness

Alert CBP Supervisor for any traveler who:

- Says he or she may have a **FEVER**
- AND**
- Reports having or is observed with **ONE or more** of the following conditions:

- Skin rash
- Swollen glands
- Jaundice
- Persistent diarrhea
- Persistent cough
- Persistent vomiting
- Difficulty breathing
- Headache with stiff neck
- Decreased consciousness
- Unexplained bleeding

Wash hands for 15-20 seconds after every incident



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- See back of card

ISOLATE

- Separate ill person ≥ 6 feet from others

NOTIFY

- If situation is life-threatening, call EMS
- Alert CBP Supervisor
- CBP Supervisor contacts CDC Quarantine Station

GIVE SUPPORT

- Follow instructions of CBP Supervisor and CDC Quarantine Station staff
